



Host Cities and Venues for 2014 Tour of Utah

1 AUGUST 4

Cedar City > Cedar City

- Second-time host city, overall start
- Host for Team Presentation event on August 2
- Home to the Utah Shakespeare Festival
- Elevation 5,840 feet; population is 29,213
- Home to Southern Utah University, which was founded in 1897

2 AUGUST 5

Panguitch > Torrey

Panguitch

- Second-time host city, Stage Two start
- County seat of Garfield County
- Located 25 miles from Bryce Canyon National Park
- Elevation 6,624 feet; population 1,520

Torrey

- Second-time host city, Stage Two finish
- Torrey is located in Wayne County, 10 miles west of Capitol Reef National Park
- Elevation 6,830 feet; population 200 in summer

3 AUGUST 6

Lehi > Miller Motorsports Park

Lehi

- The Tour has passed through Utah County each year since 2004
- Sixth time Lehi and Utah County have hosted a start, Stage Three start
- Lehi, 23 miles south of Salt Lake City, is surrounded by Utah Lake and the Oquirrh and Wasatch Mountain ranges
- Elevation 4,564 feet; population 47,407

Miller Motorsports Park

- Six-time host venue, Stage Three finish
- Last hosted Team Time Trial in 2012
- Located in Tooele, 35 miles west of Salt Lake City, on the western slopes of the Oquirrh Mountains in Tooele Valley
- Elevation 5,050 feet; population of Tooele 32,115

4 AUGUST 7

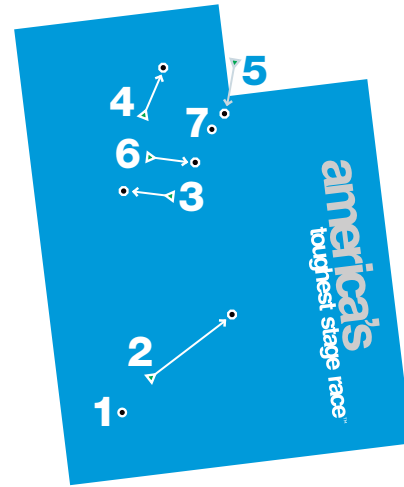
Ogden > Powder Mountain

Ogden

- Six-time host city, Stage Four start
- Last hosted the Tour in 2012 with two stages
- Known as the "Crossroads of the West", Ogden is county seat of Weber County nestled between Wasatch Mountains and Great Salt Lake
- Elevation 4,300 feet; population 82,702

Powder Mountain

- First-time host city, Stage Four finish
- Ski resort 19 miles northeast of Ogden in Eden, Utah
- North America's largest ski area with 7,000 acres of skiable terrain
- Base elevation 6,900 feet



5 AUGUST 8

Evanston > Kamas

Evanston, Wyoming

- First-time host city, Stage Five start
- First time Tour of Utah has been hosted outside the state of Utah
- Elevation 6,749 feet; population 12,359

Kamas

- First-time host city, Stage Five finish
- The Tour has passed through Kamas each year since 2006; two stages went through Kamas in 2012 and 2013
- Located in 18 miles east of Park City in Summit County
- Elevation 6,486 feet; population 1,811

6 AUGUST 9

Salt Lake City > Snowbird

Salt Lake City

- Seventh consecutive year as a host city, Stage Six start
- Hosted a circuit race for the Tour in 2013
- State Capital of Utah
- Elevation 4,226 ft; metropolitan area: population 1.1 million

Snowbird Ski and Summer Resort

- Seventh consecutive year as a host venue, Stage Six finish
- Base elevation 7,760 ft
- This is considered the "Queen Stage" of the Tour, with 8–12% gradients on final six-mile climb up Little Cottonwood Canyon
- Snowbird also hosts overall finish for The Ultimate Challenge endurance ride
- Elevation 6,486 feet; population 1,811

7 AUGUST 10

Park City > Park City

- Sixth consecutive year as a host city
- Third time as the Overall Finish Host City
- Within Park City limits, altitudes range from 6,720 ft. to 8,460 ft; population 7,558
- Home to three major ski resorts
